OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub.: Revised Procedure for taking up rehabilitation and reconstruction works in areas affected by severe calamity under MPLADS-reg.

Kind attention is invited to the MPLAD Scheme's existing procedure for taking up rehabilitation and reconstruction works in areas affected by severe calamity in the country. At present approval is done by MPLAD Division, MoSPI, of rehabilitation works recommended by Lok Sabha Members and by Rajya Sabha Committee on MPLADS for works recommended by Rajya Sabha Members, after a list of works is received from the calamity affected State. This has resulted in huge delay in execution of works. At times, the works submitted for approval are of urgent in nature, that their execution could not wait for time taken in approval process and were therefore got completed by the State from other sources. This has also resulted in frequent revision of the list of works to be completed from MPLADS funds.

2. Considering these difficulties the Ministry has revised the existing procedure for taking up rehabilitation and reconstruction works in areas affected by severe calamity as under:-

(i) *The Hon'ble Member of Parliament will give his consent through a letter as per provision 2.8 of the Guidelines on MPLADS, for rehabilitation and reconstruction works in areas affected by calamity of severe nature.*

(ii) *The Ministry would compile the total amount consented, separately for Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha, and inform the receiving State of MP wise fund consented.*

(iii) *State Nodal Department of receiving State would open a separate Bank Account to receive these funds and to take up works from the consented amount separately for Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha. The Ministry will also inform the District Authority of the consenting MP to transfer the funds to the State Nodal Department Bank Account for the purpose.*

(iv) *The State Nodal Department shall prepare list of permissible works (separately for Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha) as per MPLADS Guidelines and obtain administrative approval at the level of Chief Secretary of the State.*

(v) *The State Nodal Department shall apprise the Ministry and the consenting MPs about the list of the approved rehabilitation works being undertaken from calamity fund. Quarterly progress report for the rehabilitation and reconstruction works shall be submitted to the Ministry. The details of works should be maintained separately for the Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha Members in the enclosed format.*

3. In light of the revised procedure above, Para 2.8 and 2.8.1 of the MPLADS Guidelines stand partially modified as under:-

Para 2.8: "In the event of calamity of severe nature in any part of the country, an MP can recommend works up to a maximum of Rs 1 Crore for the affected districts. Whether a calamity is of severe nature or not, will be decided by the Government of India. The funds in this regard will be released by the District Authority of the Nodal District of the MP concerned to the affected State Government to get permissible works done. The amount so transferred from the Nodal District to the affected State may be shown in the UCs as well as MPRs as amount transferred to natural calamity affected district areas for rehabilitation work. The works completion report, Audit Certificate and Utilization Certificate for such works and funds will be provided by the affected State Government directly to the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation for overall reconciliation. No separate UC/AC/completion report in respect of the transferred amount would be required from the Nodal District Authority in this regard while processing release of subsequent instalment of MPLADS funds."

Para 2.8.1: "The Nodal Department shall identify the rehabilitation works within a period of one month of commitment of MPLADS funds and obtain approval at the level of Chief Secretary of the State. The rehabilitation works should be completed by the concerned District Authority within 8 months of the approval of the works. In case more time is required to complete the work, the Nodal Department, in consultation with MOSPI, may allow more time for completion of works."

4. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
